## Agreement between IDF Europe and Novo Nordisk A/S

**Name of the activity:** 'Diabetes is different for children – how physical activity can help', World Diabetes Day 2008 events in the European Parliament.

**Names of partnering organisations:** Novo Nordisk A/S and the International Diabetes Federation Europe (IDF Europe).

**Type of activity:** Educational Grant to be used for the organisation of political advocacy events marking World Diabetes Day 2008 in the European Parliament in Strasbourg. After the events a report in the form of a booklet will be developed and distributed, highlighting key messages and recommendations.

Between 18-20 November 2008, a delegation of children and young people with diabetes representing a broad range of EU Member States (12 in total) will be visiting the European Parliament in Strasbourg. Joint by successful sportspeople with diabetes, the Diabetes Youth Representatives will be discussing diabetes and the importance of sport and physical activity with Members and representatives of the European Commission.

**Objectives:** Increase awareness of challenges related to children and diabetes at EU political level and stimulate appropriate action by launching a set of recommendations to be used for future policy and/or legislative initiatives.

**Agreed role of Novo Nordisk A/S and IDF Europe:** IDF Europe will be responsible for the development of the programme of the World Diabetes Day events to take place in Strasbourg between 18-20 November 2008, the organisation of these events and the content of documents to be used and distributed in relation to these events. Novo Nordisk A/S will support these activities conducted by IDF Europe with a grant and will participate in the events.

**Time-frame:** 18-20 November 2008.

**Amount of funding:** 10.000 €
